REMINDER Restrictions to Curbside Parking

- Adams Street from Plymouth Street, up-to the Manhattan Bridge Archway
- Intersection of Plymouth Street / Adams Street

Installations of Maintenance and Protection of Traffic (MPT) and Storage Areas

Beginning on/about Monday, May 6, 2019, and continuing for the duration of the project 24 Hours / 7 Days

Please be advised that on/about Monday, May 6, 2019, **weather and field conditions permitting**, the NYC Dept. of Design and Construction (DDC) will begin installations of Maintenance and Protection of Traffic Plan (MPT) and storage areas. To facilitate work operations, parking restrictions will be in effect 24 hours/7 days along Adams Street from Plymouth Street to the Manhattan Bridge Archway, and at the intersection of Plymouth Street and Adams Street. Signs will be posted in advance. Please observe and adhere to all posted signage.

COMMUNITY AND TRAFFIC IMPACTS:

- "NO Parking/Driveway Access restrictions will go into effect, 24/7.
 Signs will be posted in affected areas.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
- Travel Lanes/Emergency vehicle access will be maintained at all times.
- Access to driveways will be restricted.
- Water services will be not be affected at this time.
